# Individual Drawing Permit Application Instructions

**Drivers License OR State Identification Number -**  
Enter the state abbreviation and number of your driver's license or state identification card.

**1. Date of Birth <Required>**  
Enter your date of birth.

Example: MM DD YYYY  
September 22, 1945 09 22 1945

**2-8. Personal Information <Required>**

PRINT your first, middle initial and last name exactly as it appears on your hunting license. Be sure to include Jr., III, etc. after your last name. Use only capital letters. If there are not enough boxes, continue in the blank space below name.

**9. Residency <Required>**

**Resident:** a person (including an alien) who is physically present in Alaska with the intent to remain indefinitely and make a home here, and who has maintained a domicile in Alaska for the 12 consecutive months immediately preceding the start of the hunt, and who is not claiming residency or obtaining benefits in another state, territory or country. (AS 16.05.940(27)).

**10. Alaska Hunting License <Required>**

Choose one category and fill in the required information.

Enter your Alaska hunting license number. It can be either the current year's license or next year's license.

**OR-** If you have **ALREADY** purchased a license by mail or over the internet, and have not yet received it, sign in the box. You **MUST** have purchased a license, either by mail or over the internet, prior to applying for drawing permits. A copy of your license, showing date of purchase, may be required before your permit is issued. **-OR-** If you are an Alaska resident 10-15 years of age and do not require a hunting license, enter your current age. You must be 10 years old by the starting date of the hunt.


**11. Bowhunter Certification Number**


You must have obtained your International Bowhunter Education Program (IBEP) certification in order to apply for hunts that have been restricted to bowhunting (archery) only. If you are applying for these hunts, enter your certification number.


**12. Muzzleloader Certification Number**

You must have obtained your Muzzleloader Certification in order to apply for hunts that have been restricted to Muzzleloaders only. If you are applying for these hunts, enter your certification number.

## Remember:

 Use hunt numbers listed in the 2010 Drawing Supplement.

 Apply only once for the same hunt number on all (individual, party, or internet) applications combined.

 Apply for no more than 3 different hunts per species on all (individual, party, internet) applications combined.

 If you won a permit last year, you are ineligible for the same hunt number this year.

 If you apply by internet, do not apply by mail for the same hunts. It will invalidate your applications.

 Applications postmarked after Dec. 15 or received after Dec. 29 will be returned to sender.



Some hunts require a signed guide-client agreement before or at the time of application. These hunts are identified with the "handshake" symbol at left.

**Credit card payments are accepted online only. If applying on paper application, you MUST pay by check, money order or cashiers check.**

## CSN-Customer Service Number

The department is in the process of assigning unique identification numbers to each hunter. Some hunters may have received these in the mail prior to this application period. If so, please enter that number on the front of this application. If you did NOT receive one, please leave this space blank.

## ATTENTION PARTY APPLICANTS:

**Be aware that if you apply for a party hunt with someone who is disqualified for failure to report or for applying for too many hunts for one species, both the disqualified hunter and the other party listed on the application are disqualified for that hunt.**

Due to the very low volume of party applications submitted, party applications must be completed using the online application process. Printed party applications will no longer be available, and paper copies will not be accepted. Two hunters may still apply as a party, but must apply online at the address shown in the "apply online" box below.

## HOW TO APPLY ONLINE

Choose your hunt(s) from the 2010-2011 Drawing Supplement. Once you know which hunt(s) you wish to apply for, gather your notes, your current hunting license, your credit card, and you are ready to begin the online application process. Type the following Internet address into your browser URL window:

**Attention Nonresident Hunters:** Some nonresident guided hunts require you to have a signed guide-client agreement before or at the time of application. This agreement is available through your guide. If you apply for one of these hunts (marked in the supplement with the handshake symbol above left) you must write the name of your registered guide (or resident relative within second-degree of kindred) in the box provided, and check the appropriate box to indicate whether this person is a guide or a qualifying relative. If you do not supply this information, your application will be rejected.

## Kodiak Brown Bear Hunts

**Nonresident** applicants applying for guided Kodiak Brown Bear hunts have only 1 choice per season. Residents and nonresidents accompanied by 2<sup>nd</sup>-degree kindred relatives have a maximum of 3 choices.

**100 Series Bear Hunt Numbers** Kodiak Bear Hunts  
**Open to Nonresidents** hunting with a registered guide (may apply for 1 fall hunt and 1 spring hunt)

**200 Series Bear Hunt Numbers** Kodiak Bear Hunts

**Open to Residents & Nonresidents** hunting with a 2<sup>nd</sup>-degree kindred relative.

**2<sup>nd</sup>-Degree Kindred:** a relative who is an Alaska resident over 19 years of age and is your: father, mother, brother, sister, son, daughter, spouse, grandparent, grandchild, brother- or sister-in-law, stepfather, stepmother, stepsister, stepbrother, stepson or stepdaughter. (5 AAC 92.990).
